

Finding Nemo-The Musical

Overview: Witness the Broadway-caliber musical retelling of the Disney-Pixar animated film *Finding Nemo* as Marlin, Dory and Crush work together to rescue Nemo. The theater seats 1,500 guests.

Thrill Time: 30 minutes

Be Aware of: The queue line for this attraction is outside with no shade.

Seating for this show is on benches with back rests. To access most of the seating, you will have to climb steps. If you cannot climb steps, ask a cast member to be seated in the disabled section, but you must arrive early because seating in this area is very limited.

There are loud noises and a segment featuring sharks during the show.

Helpful Hints: Restroom facilities are located just outside of the theater on the right.

Disabled Access: Guests may remain in their wheelchair or motorized scooter. Disney's assistive listening devices interact with this attraction. Reflective captioning is available.
