

# Pirates of the Caribbean

*Overview:* Take a leisurely boat ride through an 18<sup>th</sup> century seaport under siege by pirates, including Captain Jack Sparrow from Disney's *Pirates of the Caribbean* film series. Your 20-passenger boat (six rows each hold approximately four adults and children) sails through comical scenes of 125 Audio-Animatronic pirates invading the town and searching for treasures.

*Thrill Time:* 7 ½ minutes


*Be Aware of:* There is one small drop in the pitch dark with a mild splash at the beginning of the ride. There are periods of darkness as well as gunshot and fire elements.

The queue line has slight inclines and declines. At the end of the attraction, the boats sometimes bump together while you are waiting to exit. After disembarking the boat, guests exit the attraction via a steep, inclined moving walkway.

*Helpful Hints:* This dark ride with cool breezes is the perfect attraction for hot and humid days.

*Disabled Access:* Guests must transfer from a motorized scooter to a wheelchair. Guests must transfer from a wheelchair and step down into the ride vehicle. Disney's handheld captioning devices interact with this attraction.
