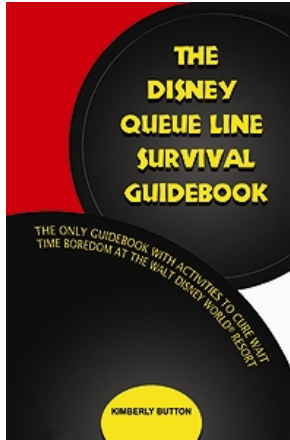


# End the Boredom of Waiting in Disney's Theme Park Lines with Unique Activity Guidebook
