

## **Turtle Talk With Crush**

*Overview:* Enjoy the unusual experience of talking with an animated character during this comical interactive show which features Crush, the sea turtle from the Disney-Pixar animated film *Finding Nemo*, who has unique, personalized conversations with each 150-member audience – no two shows will ever be alike!

*Thrill Time:* 14 ½ minutes

*Be Aware of:* Turtle Talk With Crush has bench seating without back rests.

*Helpful Hints:* If you just want to experience Turtle Talk With Crush without entering The Seas With Nemo & Friends pavilion by way of The Seas with Nemo & Friends attraction, enter the pavilion through the exit located to the left of the queue line entrance for The Seas with Nemo & Friends. Turtle Talk With Crush will be located inside the pavilion to the left, past the gift shop area.

Members of your party who choose not to experience the attraction can wait inside The Seas With Nemo & Friends pavilion where there are exhibits featuring *Finding Nemo* characters, as well as exhibits on marine life and the opportunity to look through the large glass walls of the massive two-story aquarium.

While waiting in the queue line, children can have fun with the exhibits in Bruce’s Sub House which is nearby and within view of adults standing in portions of the queue line.

The pavilion features restroom facilities, telephones, water fountains and a gift shop.

In the theater, there are benches for the adults while kids are encouraged to sit on the floor in the front of the theater so that Crush can “talk” with them. Tell your kids not to be shy about sitting on the floor - once the show starts everyone tries to get a spot up front so that they can talk to Crush (parents can sit with their children, but only in the back sections of the floor). If your child wants to have the unique experience of talking with an animated character which will call him or her by name, be sure to think of a question about the underwater world, turtles, fish, etc. before the show starts. When Crush asks if the humans have any questions for him, if your child is one of the first with their hand in the air they have a very good chance of talking with Crush.

Be sure to stick around after the show is over, too. Crush often comes back out to watch the humans leave and continues his antics as guests are exiting the theater.

*Disabled Access:* Guests may remain in their wheelchair or motorized scooter. Disney’s assistive listening devices interact with this attraction. Reflective captioning is available. Disney’s guest-activated captioning devices interact with this attraction.
